CLI prioritizes books that center Black and Latinx children and affirm their identities and life experiences, offering mirrors to these children. We customize collections to provide the windows and mirrors needed in a particular classroom or school. The books have a balance of genres, fiction and non-fiction. The books appeal to students' interests, gender and cultures, and are appropriate for both instruction and student enjoyment.

Student Impact - Philadelphia

Increases in schools' growth rates reflect the high collaboration between CLI's Early Literacy Coaches and school-based Literacy leads and principals. Despite the unpredictable disruptions to our children's learning, CLI has continued to support amplified reading outcomes.

CLI advanced a 15-percentage point increase, on average, of the percentage of students per school performing at or above reading benchmarks between fall 2021 and spring 2022.

96%

96% of schools CLI served saw an increase in the percentage of students performing at or above reading benchmarks between fall and spring.

CLI-served schools saw a 10- percentage point decrease on average of the percentage of students per school in the highest reading support tier between fall and spring.
